- 1871 Born in Green Bay, Wisconsin. His parents came from St. Anne, IL Church. Joined Église du Calvaire, Doty Street, Green Bay.
- 1884 Church trustee, Église du Calvaire. His signature found on this certificate

- 1893 Admitted to the missionary Society of the Precious Blood (S.P.B.) 23 March. Ordained to the ministry 1894. Missionary among the Menominee Indians
- 1896 Sent to Quebec. Missionary in Kildare (St. Ambroise) and Brandon (St. Gabriel). Assisted Father J.B. Gauthier at St. Ursula Falls, Maskinonge County.
- 1897 Rector of Greater Montreal Parish. Succeeded by Fr. Ed O'Neill in 1910.
- Finished his days in Baltimore, U.S.A. Died in the 1940's.
